In the name of God. Amen I Chichester Matthews of Boone County and State of Kentucky being of sound mind and disposing memory, and knowing the uncertainty of life desire to dispose of such estate with which it has been pleased God to bless me, do make constitute and ordain this my last will and testament in manner following (to wit.)

1st I give and bequeath all my estate both real and personal to my beloved wife Agnes Matthews during her natural life.

2nd My wish and desire is that all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid.

3rd My will and desire is that after the death of my beloved wife as aforesaid that such of my estate both real and personal as shall then remain shall be divided in the following manner that is four fifths to Aylse Beat and her heirs forever, and the other one fifth to Jolyann Dodger and to her heirs forever, but with this exception that should the said Jolyann Dodger die without a lawful heir of her body then and in that case is that the one fifth of my estate before named bequeathed her in this will go to the said Aylse Beat and her heirs as the four fifths is hereby bequeathed her.

4th My will and desire is that my beloved wife as aforesaid be and is vested with full power if she came to emancipate and release from further bondage my negro man Fortune by will so that after his decease he the said Fortune enjoy his freedom.

5th I hereby appoint my beloved wife as aforesaid executrix of this my last will and testament.
