Dulaney the former Guardian of said infant heirs this Day called upon us the undersigned commissioners to state and settle the accounts of the said Benjamin M. Dulaney Guardian as aforesaid and we having examined all the vouchers in relation thereto make the following report we find the said guardian in possession of two negro fellows one by the name of Rufus and the other Jacob and that the said guardian took possession of said two slaves early in the year 1835 and has hired them out for the years 1835, 1836 and eighteen Hundred & thirty seven in the year 1835 Rufus was hired for \$50.00 in 1836 \$110.00 in 1837 \$120.00 making \$280.00 and Jacob was hired in the year 1835 for \$80.00 in the year 1836 \$120.00 in the year 1837 \$120.00 making \$320.00 which added to the \$225.00 for which Rufus hired makes an aggregate amount of \$605.00 so that the debt stands thus
