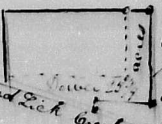

The Conformity to an order of Boone County Court December Term 1838 appointing us commissioners to allot and set apart the lands of Elizabeth Robridge in the lands of Silas Robridge her deceased husband the undersigned being first duly sworn do Report that the lands of said dec'd as far as came to our knowledge consisted of a tract of 9 acres or rather two adjoining tracts one of 4 acres the other of 5 acres on Mudlick Creek including the late Residence of said dec'd and that we did apportion 2 1/2 acres off of the west side and south end of said tract and left the 6 1/2 acres on the above plat which is bounded

As follows To wit Beginning at a poplar stump in a field thence with 20 poles to a Beech tree stump thence west 61 poles to a Black Locust thence north 114 poles to a Beech and Sugar tree on the Bank of the creek thence North 7 ps to three bysanges in the center of the creek thence down the same 88 1/2 W. Poles to two sugar trees corner of the tract of 46 acres thence north it East 10 poles to white oak and horn beam corner of the tract of 45 and down beam acres thence with the East tract south 80 poles to two white oaks thence East 90 poles to the beginning - Given under our hands this 1 day of May 1839-
