I, Gabriel Hawkins of the County of Boone and State of Kentucky, being weak of body but of sound mind and disposing free will, do hereby make and declare this to be my last will and Testament. In the words and terms following to wit: First of all it is my will and desire that my body be buried in decent Christian burial after my death. And secondly that all my just debts be paid by my Executors herein after mentioned. And Thirdly that my Executors herein after mentioned be authorized and I do hereby appoint them each full power to manage and adjust all law suits now depending and undetermined in the Boone Circuit Court wherein the heirs of Willis Francis Lee are plaintiffs against my said defendant in Ejectment as they may deem proper either by continuing the same to the end and extent of the law in such cases or by compromise or otherwise which they may deem most expedient. And Fourthly after said adjustment of the said affairs as it regards my land is settled and all my just debts paid it is my will and desire that my Executors

Shall retain all the household and kitchen furniture forming the stock to which I may be heir and disposed of at the time of my death which the said Executors shall sell either in part and portion of my landed estate which may be devised by law to my children or otherwise as the case before decided as the may see fit or it may be considered most advantageous by the advice and consent of my Executors herein after mentioned always having and respecting to my wife and my Executors herein after named an eye directed to the education and tuition of my children so as to promote each in advancement equally.

And should it at any time seem expedient and advisable to my wife and my said Executors herein after mentioned that it should be expedient to sell my slaves or slave land or lands for the interest or promotion of my said wife and children I desire that they be and they are hereby authorized to do the same and in doing the same the proceeds thereof to be at all times applied for the promotion of my said children as aforesaid. And lastly I do hereby appoint my said wife Elizabeth Hawkins William Henry and Elgar Hawkins Executors to this my last will and Testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my name and affixed my hand this 21st day of July 1835.
