County of Boone and State of Kentucky being now in
a low state of health but of a sound mind and being
sensible of the uncertainty of life and certainty of death
Do make this my last will and testament in the
manner and form following (viz) first I commend
my soul to god who gave it and body to be buried in
a decent and Christian life manner at the direction
of my Executor here after to be named and as to what
worldly goods I now possess I devise that they be dispo-
sed of as followeth (viz) and first I do bequeath unto
my beloved son Luke Points fifty acres of land out
of the fifty five acres that was sold of to him when
he now lives reserving the odd five acres in the sugar
Camp in form agreed to between him & myself and second
I do bequeath unto my beloved wife Lane Points one
third of my whole Estate both real & personal except the
above mentioned fifty acres of land with my man-
sion house and all its conveniences to be on her third
of the land which she is to hold during life after which
time it shall be equally divided between the follow-
ing part of my children (viz) John Points Arthur
Points and William Points my sons and Susannah
Points Nancy Points Lane Points and Sarah my daughter
And third I do bequeath unto my beloved son John
Points the mace and coll which are now owned by
me and to my beloved son Arthur Points the horse saddle
and bridle which he now claims And I hereby be-
queath unto my beloved son William Points one
horse saddle and bridle to be worth fifty Dollars
when he arrives to full age and I do also bequeath
unto my beloved daughter Susanna Points one horse
to be worth thirty Dollars and the saddle she now owns
And I do also bequeath unto my beloved daughter
Nancy Points one horse and saddle to be worth
fifty Dollars when she arrives to full age And I do
also bequeath unto my beloved daughter Lane Points
one horse and saddle to be worth fifty Dollars when
she arrives to full age And I do also bequeath unto
my beloved daughter Sarah Points one horse and saddle

I desire to be worth fifty Dollars when she arrives to full age to be paid out of my Estate personal or real And do also bequeath unto my beloved daughter Abigail Wilson five Shillings Sterling to be paid out of my Estate The balance of my whole Estate After my Just Debts are paid to be equally divided among the following Children viz John Points Arthur Points William Points my son and Susannah Points Mary Points Jane Points and Sarah Points my daughters And I do lay these presents constitute and appoint Jane Points my wife to be whole and sole executor and do also by these presents acknowledge this to be my last will and testament Given under my hand and seal this 20th of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirten -

November one thousand eight hundred and eighty nine I William Corbin of the District of North Carolina the County of Casper being sick and weak in Body but of perfect mind and memory do make and ordain this my last will and testament in manner and form following Verily - principally and first of all I commend my soul into the hands of Almighty God who gave it and my body to the earth to be buried in a Christian Burial at the discretion of my Executors herein after mentioned and as in what verbally goods it hath pleased God to bestow me with in this life I give and bequeath and dispose of the same in the following manner and form - I give and bequeath and assign is that my Just Debts & funeral expenses be satisfied & paid I am I give and bequeath to my son Benjamin Corbin my wagon and team of Horses which he now has in possession -

I am I lend unto Sarah Corbin my Dearest beloved wife all the rest and residue of my Estate both real and personal during her natural life and after her decease I give bequeath and dispose of the same as follows -

I am I give and bequeath unto my son Benjamin Corbin afore mentioned one negro wench Sarah & child Lydia and all their future increase -

I am I give in like manner unto my son Lewis Corbin one negro wench Hannah and all her future increase - I am I give in like manner unto my

son William Corbin one negro wench Nann and all her future increase -

I am I give in like manner unto my son David Corbin the land and plantation whereon I now live

I am I give in like manner unto my daughter Mary Corbin one negro wench Estlin's all her future increase

I am I give in like manner unto Elizabeth Thacker Corbin daughter of my son John Corbin one negro girl Daphnia and all her future increase

I am I give and bequeath unto my daughter Sarah Corbin one negro boy Daniel and like wife my land and desire is that my said daughter have these a young negro wench
