

Know all men by these presents that Lewis Riddell of the Town of Burlington County of Boone and State of Kentucky, being sick in body and in declining health, but of sound and disposing mind and memory have thought proper to make my last will and testament and do by these presents

(Will. make) and declare this my last will and testament hereby revoking all former wills or testaments by me made or attempted to be made.

And first it is my will and desire that all of my just debts shall be paid by my Executors herein after named as soon after my decease as the same can be done with the money arising from the debts due and to become due me, and of such debts due and to become due to me are insufficient to discharge the debts which I am owing or cannot be collected in time to meet the demands against my estate; then I wish my Executors to raise the balance of the sum which may be necessary to meet such demands against my estate by the sale of such of my personal property as my family can most conveniently spare.

Second. Whereas I have advanced to my daughter Meliscent Pate property consisting of One negro girl named Jane and other articles the whole of which I estimate at five hundred dollars. It is my will and desire and I hereby Order and direct my Executors to advance and deliver to each of my Other children as they shall respectively become of age or marry a sum equal in amount to that advanced by me to my said daughter Meliscent Pate, to be advanced to my Other children in such property as they shall then stand in greatest need of.

Third. It is my will and desire that my family should continue to reside together and be under the control of my wife Ann Riddell after my decease & provided for in a decent and comfortable manner out of my estate until my children shall respectively arrive at lawful age or marry. And it is my will and desire that my estate should not be divided or distributed until all of my children shall have arrived at lawful age or married, except as herein before and hereafter directed.

Fourth. I hereby will and bequeath to my wife Ann Riddell during her natural life the one third part of my estate, and after her death the said third part willed to her is hereby willed and bequeathed to my children, but it is my will and desire and I hereby

will and direct that in case my wife Ann Riddell should ever marry that no part of my estate herein willed to her should at any time be subject to the control or management of her husband, but that the said third part of my estate herein willed to her should from the time of such her second marriage rest in and be held by my Other executors herein after named for the use and benefit of my said wife during her natural life and at her death rest in and belong to my children, it being my wish and desire that should my wife marry she and her husband should from the time of such marriage have no control over any part of my estate as devisee, Executrix or guardian but that the whole duty of executing this my will should devolve on my Other Executors herein after named, Fifth. I will and bequeath to my Children Meliscent Pate, Ann Riddell, Medaline Riddell, Charles James Riddell Lafayette Riddell, and Mary Jane Riddell, all of my estate both real and personal in proportion to the number of my children and all my right and title to every species of property which I now possess and which is not otherwise disposed of by this my will. Or which may be now due or shall hereafter be due & coming to me by purchase inheritance or devise to them and their heirs forever to be paid over to & put into the possession of my said children when they shall all have arrived at lawful age or married as aforesaid while it is my wish that all of my estate except what may be advanced to my Other children, according to the second item of this will or what may be sold for the payment of my debts should remain in the possession and care of my Executors by them to be managed as they may think most to the interest of my devisees.

Sixth. I will and bequeath to my son Charles James Riddell my silver pocket watch and to my wife Ann Riddell my gold watch.

Seventh. I will & bequeath to my Old negro man Ben his freedom from and after my decease on condition that he leave the State of Kentucky, immediately thereafter and shall forever thereafter continue to reside without the limits of the same.

Eighth. My will and desire is that in case of the death of either of my children without heirs the portion of such one or more of them so dying without heirs

shall descend to and be equally divided among the survivors or survivor.

Fourth. my will and desire is and I hereby nominate and appoint my wife Ann Riddell Guardian of my children who I wish to have an opportunity to have as good an education as my estate & their abilities will admit of.

Fifth. I hereby authorize and empower my executors hereafter to be named, to manage all the concerns of my estate both real & personal, to make sales of such of my personal as they may think proper to alienate to the renting & leasing of all my lands and houses & to receiving the rents and profits to alienate to having all my contracts which I have entered into executed and fully carried into effect. And for this purpose I hereby authorize them to sign & acknowledge any deed or other conveyance which may be in pursuance of any contract entered into by me, and also to alienate to receiving conveyances for any property which I may have purchased & not yet have obtained a deed for and I further authorize my Executors should they think it proper to sell either or any of my slaves and further to do & transact all of my business of every description until the same is closed and a distribution of my estate is made in pursuance of foregoing provisions of this my will.

Sixth. It is my wish in relation to the second item of this will that each of my other children should have a sum equal to that advanced to my daughter Meliseth Ratt advanced to them before a final distribution of my estate is made and it is also my wish that the third of my estate herein before devised to my wife should not be assigned and laid off to her until all of my children arrives at lawful age or marry and a final division is made among them.

It is also my wish will and desire in relation to the fourth item of this my will that in case of the marriage of my wife Ann Riddell the third part of my estate therein bequeathed to her should be held and the title thereof vested in my other executors hereinafter named during the natural life of my said wife Ann Riddell to and for the separate use and maintenance of my

said wife in such a manner that her husband should the marry can neither consume or use either the <sup>3rd</sup> property or the use reserved thereon to my said wife.

Seventh. I hereby nominate constitute and appoint my wife Ann Riddell Executrix & my son in law John Ratt and brother in law Charles Chambers Executors of this my last will and Testament.
