In conformity to an order of Boone County Court Feb
Term 1832. We the undersigned Commissioners being duly sworn dep
On the 9th day of October 1832. proceed to discharge the duties assigned us and
do report that the real Estate of Martin Lantz dec^d so far as came to
our knowledge consisted of a tract of land on the Ohio River at the
mouth of Garrison Creek containing about 66 acres and that we attached
and set apart to Mary Queen late Mary Lantz, widow of said Martin
Lantz dec^d of the tract of land aforesaid 18 3/4 acres including the dwell-
ing house of said dec^d as her dower in and to the land & improvements of
said which is bounded as follows to wit: Beginning at the mouth
of Garrison Creek thence down the Ohio river 28 1/2 poles to two maple
trees corner of Willis Grimes thence with his line S 4 E. 18 1/2 poles
to a stake in the road thence with it S 3 E. 5 1/2 poles to a mulberry
tree thence N 60 E. 28 1/2 poles to a hickory stump corner of John Whitaker
thence with his line N 57 1/2 E. 39 1/2 poles to a walnut tree thence S 43 W.
28 poles to a sugar tree thence same course continued 36 poles to
the beginning. Given under our hands as Commissioners of
this 9th day of October 1832.
