Sales, James P. Prior, Thomas A. Prior, Richardson C. Prior, John C. Prior & William C. Prior. It also my will and desire that negro man Reuben should at the death of my wife be manumitted and have his freedom as he has been a good and faithful servant to me. It is my will and desire that my sister Elizabeth Prior should be well supported out of my estate during her natural life. It is also my will that the land which John W. Sales purchased of me and Hester Prior shall be his and his heirs and assigns forever. I hereby appoint Richardson C. Prior & Thomas Nelson executor of this my last will and testament, hereby revoking all former wills by me made.
