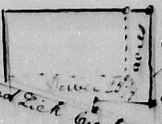

The Conformity to an order of Boone County Court December Term 1838 appointing us commissioners to allot and set apart the lands of Elizabeth Robridge in the lands of Silas Robridge her deceased husband the undersigned being first duly sworn do Report that the lands of said decd as far as came to our knowledge consisted of a tract of 9 acres or rather two adjoining tracts one of 4 acres the other of 5 acres on Mudlick Creek including the late Residence of said decd and that we did apportion 2 1/2 acres off of the west side and south end of said tract and left the 6 1/2 acres on the above plat which is bounded
