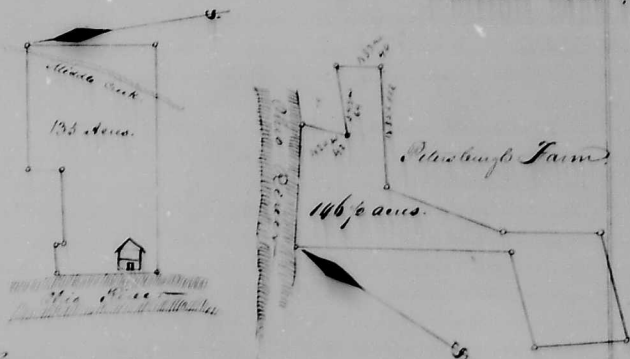

Surveyed for Ann M. Webb widow and Heir of Benjamin & Willis deceased One hundred and thirty five acres of land including the late residence and other houses of said de^d and appraised to her as her dower in the tract of land on and the bank of the Ohio River by the Commissioners appointed by Boone County Court for that purpose.
Beginning at a Sugar tree limb and corner on the easterly side of the bank of the Ohio river thence through the center of the barn at 81¹/₂ E 26¹/₂ poles to a stake thence S 8¹/₂ E 5¹/₂ poles to a stake in the center of the lane thence with it N 81¹/₂ E 68 poles to a hick tree thence N 8¹/₂ W 30 poles to a hick tree thence at 81¹/₂ N 15 poles to a hick tree on the East bank of Middle Creek thence S 8¹/₂ E 46¹/₂ poles to a hick tree & Sugar tree thence S 81¹/₂ W 90 poles to a hick tree on the bank of the Ohio thence up it by the Meanders to the beginning

112 poles to a stake thence with the line at 35 S 112 poles to a stake in the top of Pinstrip thence N 33 W 40 poles to a stake thence with the Orchard fence S 44 W 64 poles to a stake corner of the Orchard thence with it N 20 W 12 poles to a stake on the bank of the Ohio river thence down it by its meanders 41 poles to the beginning
