and testament

First I commend my soul into the hands of Almighty
God that gave it; and my body to be buried in
a decent Christian burial nothing doubting
but that I shall receive the same again by
the mighty power of God and as to my worldly
goods I have with the Lord has blessed me
with I give and bequeath in the following
manner

Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife
Barbary Green during her natural life or
widowhood the land plantation which I
now live on with the farming utensils, household
and kitchen furniture I with all my stock of
every description which are the whole of my life

Item I give to my daughter Polly Herrick and
negro woman named Reb. one day dollar house
and ten dollar and one calf which is to go to her
legal heirs after her death; all of which she
is to receive after the death of my wife

Item I give to my son William Green and ten
dollars and one calf which she is to receive
after the death of my wife

Item I give to my daughter Lucy Simpson and
negro woman named Jenny which is to
already have in possession which is to go
to her legal heirs after her death

Item I give to my daughter Mary Campbell and
negro woman named Daph which she is to
receive after the death of my wife which
is to go to her legal heirs after her death

Item I give to my daughter Elizabeth Allen
one negro woman named Fanny which
she is to receive after the death of my
wife which is to go to her legal heirs
after

I give to my son Thomas Green the land
and plantation on which I now live and
all my stock horses, a good steady horse
and ten dollar and one calf which he is
to receive after the death of my wife and
her children

Item I give to my granddaughter Barbary Campbell
one day dollar house and ten dollar and one
calf and good horse which she is to receive after
the death of my wife

Item I give to my daughter that three children that I have
given negro women shall have their increase
with them

Item The balance of my Estate I wish to be equally
divided between my children namely Polly
Herrick, William, Lucy Simpson, Mary
Campbell, Elizabeth Green, Elizabeth
Allen & Thomas Green. I appoint my
wife Barbary Green Executor of said
William, Nathaniel & Thomas Green
my sons and Christopher Nelson executors
of my son and son-in-law & I recommend
