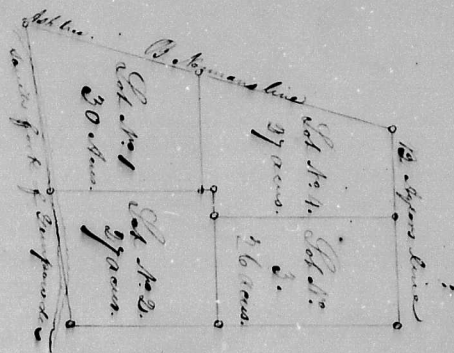


In conformity to an Order of Poore County Court. Term 1837
 directing the Commissioners to divide and sell the land estate of
 Mr. Herod & Thomas Herod & P. among the Heirs of said Mr. Herod & P.
 Land divided into 4 parcels. Commissioners being first duly sworn do on the
 7th day of March 1837. proceed to divide and sell to the best
 adv. a tract of 110 acres of land in Poore County on the North
 fork of Kumpston Creek including the late residence of said
 Mr. Herod & P. to the following tract and subjects of the same
 as follows to wit:



Lot No. 1. To Andrew H. Herod Containing 30 acres
 Lot No. 2. To John H. Herod Containing 27 acres.
 Lot No. 3. To Benjamin Herod Containing 27 acres.
 Lot No. 4. To Thomas Herod Containing 27 acres.
 We the said lots are considered equal in value.
 The boundary of each lot is as follows to wit:

Lot No. 1. Beginning at an ash tree on the East line
 of the land of the Commissioners thence with King's & Thomas
 line 89 W. 92¹/₂ poles to a stake corner. N 90 W. 54 poles to a
 stake corner. N 90 E. 72 poles to a stake corner. S 90 E. 72 poles to the
 East line of the land thence up it 78 poles to the be-
 ginning containing 30 acres.

Lot No. 2. Beginning at a stake corner of Lot No. 1 thence
 N 20 W. 62¹/₂ poles to two beech trees in the B. & G. line thence
 with it. N 90 E. 64 poles to a stake corner of said B. & G. line
 S 90 E. 64 poles to a stake corner. S 90 E. 64 poles to the East
 line of the land thence up it 72 poles to the be-
 ginning containing 27 acres.

Lot No. 3. Beginning at a stake corner of Lot No. 1 thence
 S 89 W. 92¹/₂ poles to an ash stump corner of B. & G. line thence
 with it. N 90 W. 10 poles to a beech tree corner. N 90 E.
 82 poles to a stake corner. S 90 E. 13 poles to a stake
 corner. N 90 E. 5 poles to a stake corner of Lot No. 1. thence
 with a line thence S 90 E. 54 poles to the beginning
 containing 27 acres.

Lot No. 3. Beginning at a beech tree in B. & G. line thence
 with it. N 90 W. 50 poles to a beech tree corner of B. & G. line
 thence with it. N 90 E. 62 poles to two beech trees
 thence S 90 E. 50 poles to an oak and beech thence up it 72
 poles to the beginning, containing 26 acres.
 Note the Commission of Lot No. 4 was inserted before to pre-
 pare place put it is correct.
