nine William Cobb of the Parish of St. Marks in
the County of Outispa being sick and weak in
Body but of perfect mind and memory do make
and ordain this my last will and Testament
in manner and form following Verily -
principally and first of all I recommend my soul into
the hands of Almighty God who gave it and my body
to the earth to be buried in a Christian Burial at the
discretion of my Executors herein after mentioned and
as in what wholly goods it hath pleased God to
keep me with in this life I give and bequeath and
dispose of the same in the following manner and
form - In witness My wife and again is that my
Just Debts & funeral expenses be satisfied & paid
I am I give and bequeath to my son Benjamin
Cobb my wagon and team of Horses which he now
has in possession -

I am I lend unto Sarah Cobb my Dearest beloved
wife all the rest and residue of my Estate both real
and personal during her natural life and after her
decease I give bequeath and dispose of the same
as follows -

I am I give and bequeath unto my son Benjamin
Cobb afore mentioned one negro wench Sarah & child
Lydia and all their future increase -

I am I give in like manner unto my son Lewis
Cobb one negro wench Hannah and all her future
increase - I am I give in like manner unto my
son William Cobb one negro wench Nann and
all her future increase -

I am I give in like manner unto my son David Cobb
him the land and plantation whereon I now live
I am I give in like manner unto my daughter Mary
Cobb one negro wench Estlin's all her future increase -

I am I give in like manner unto Elizabeth Thax
or Cobb daughter of my son John Cobb one
negro girl Daphnia and all her future increase -

I am I give and bequeath unto my daughter
Hagant one negro boy Daniel and like wise my land
and desire is that my said daughter give three
a young negro wench

240 out that part of my estate not already bequeathed
 During her natural life and that her husband
 William Grant - shall possess said Slave during
 his life provided he shall be the longest lived but
 if my said Daughter Ann should die without issue
 that then after her and her husband's death the
 said Slave and their increase to return to my
 Estate and be disposed of by my Executors accord-
 ing to law - I then give and bequeath unto
 my daughter Margaret Wether one negro girl
 Lucy of likewise a young negro woman to be pur-
 chased or raised out my estate and all their future
 increase - I likewise make constitute & appoint
 my sons John Corbin William Corbin & my
 aforesaid wife Sarah Corbin Executors of this my
 last will and testament and do hereby utter
 this will and testament in writing and every form
 and in other to be my last will and testament.

In witness whereof I have hereunto set my
 hand and seal the day and year first above

This last will and testament of William Corbin
 last was exhibited to the Court and fully proved
 by the oath of Andrew Grant a witness thereto
 and ordered to be certified - And at a Court held
 for said County the 17 day of June 1797 this said
 will was fully proved by the oath of Thomas Spelman
 the other witness thereto and ordered to be
 recorded. And on the motion of John Corbin
 one of the Executors therein named Certificate
 is granted him for obtaining a probat thereof - in due
 form he having made oath thereto and given bond
 & security according to law. Liberty being granted
 for the other Executors to join in the probat when
