In the name of God amen. I Alexander Mitchell of the County of Bourbon and State of Kentucky being weak in body but of sound and perfect mind and memory blessed be Almighty God for the same do make and Publish this my last will and testament in manner and form following (that is to say). First I give and bequeath un- to my beloved wife Jane Mitchell and my sons Joseph Mitchell & John Mitchell my Daughter Patsy Mitchell & Hannah Mitchell all my personal Estate con-
-ting-

ting of Horses two Shapand hogs together with
 household and kitchen furniture farming
 utensils &c. to be by them held jointly under
 the guidance and direction of my beloved
 wife Jean. Mitchell so long as the above na-
 med Joseph John Patsey and Hannah con-
 tinue to live unmarried and in case either
 of the last above named should marry
 the shall be entitled to an equal dividend
 of the property then on hand and in case
 of a disagreement concerning the divi-
 -dend the person claiming is to choose one
 man and the other legates another man
 both to be disinterested to whom the affair
 is to be referred and in case of a disagree-
 ment between the two men chosen the
 are to choose a third person which three
 men is to estimate and set aside the divi-
 -dend accordingly. Secondly. In case a
 good and sufficient title should be obtain-
 ed of John Lewis and Robert Johnston for
 the message or tenement of land whereon
 I now live I hereby gave and bequeath un-
 -to my beloved wife Jean. Mitchell one
 equal third part of said land or tenement

so as to include the mansion house
 with all the appurtenances thereunto
 belonging he have and to hold until
 her death then to revert to the above na-
 med Joseph and John Mitchell. I do al-
 so give and bequeath unto my sons -
 Joseph Mitchell and John Mitchell their
 heirs or assigns all that my messuage or
 tenement whereon I now live to hold to
 them the said Joseph and John their heirs
 and assigns forever Equally to be divided
 between them quantity and quality. except
 as before stated respecting my beloved wife
 having one third of said tenement during
 her life then to revert to the said Joseph and
 John as before stated. Thirdly. I do hereby
 declare that my will is that my heirs and
 legal representatives do cause to be made
 unto Joseph Kirkpatrick a title to one hun-
 dred acres of land whereon he now lives
 agreeable to a bond he the said Kirkpa-
 trick holds on me. Lastly. I do hereby
 constitute and appoint Jean Mitchell
 my sole executor of this my last will &
 testament hereby revoking all former
