In the name of god Amen
I John Smith of Bourbon County & State of
Kentucky being in a low state of health & weak
in body yet of perfect mind and memory thanks
be to god for all his mercies but feeling to mind
the mortality of my body and knowing that it
is appointed for me to die I do make & declare
this my last will & Testament that is to say first
of all I recommend my soul to the great god
& my body to the earth from whence it came
& to be buried in a decent manner in hopes
it shall be entered at the Resurrection
and as touching such worldly effects as it hath
pleased god to bless me with in this life
I do give & bequeath
first all my lawful Debt I do owe and other

112 to be lawfully discharged
I give to my wife Catherine Smith who has stayed from
my bed and bears the care of thirty pounds
Shillings & three pence and an Inventory of which
is in my executor hands which has to be paid
if required
then I give and bequeath to William Mc Lane of I
by all my notes bonds and obligations together
with all my household goods Debt & moveables
first I do make & appoint James Arvey & John Mathews
the sole Executors of this my last will and Testament
and I do - - - utterly Discharge Release & Quittance
all and every other former Testament with & bequest
bequests to Authenticate and confirm this and no other
to be my last will and Testament In witness
whereof I have set my hand and seal this second
Day of February in the year of our Lord one
thousand seven hundred & Ninety four
