In the Name of God Amen I Christian Spears of Bour-
son County and State of Kentucky, being weak in body
but perfect and sound in senses and memory and
knowing the uncertainty of this life do make this
my last will and Testament, in manner and form
following: First I desire I may be buried plain
but decent, and my Executors pay all my just
debts out of any part of my personal Estate they
shall think best. I desire that my son John
shall have my Negro Boy Abraham that my son
Adam shall have my Negro boy Sidener, and
that my son Henry shall have my Negro boy Miller,
to be received by them as a part of the Estate, I be-
queath them at the valuation of the boys respectively.
Secondly It is my desire that the plantation wherein
I now live shall be sold by my Executors and that
they proceed to improve and prepare the plantation
in Harrison County, which I bought of Aaron Griff-
ing for the residence and home of my wife Ann
Henry, and if that land should be lost, I thereby
direct that my Executors shall appropriate so much
of the proceeds of the sale of my land to be sold as
will purchase for my wife and Children a good of

189. land to make a comfortable home for them, and that my
wife have the quiet possession of it during her life.
Thirdly, I direct that all my estates shall be equally
divided amongst my children, taking care that those
of them which have had properly given to them shall
account for the same as part of their share of the estate.
Fourthly, I direct that all my personal property shall
be at the disposition of my executors to be sold or
not as they shall judge most advisable for the bene-
fit of my children, and that my wife shall have
one third part of the personal estate or more if it shall
be necessary for the comfortable support of herself
and children, and especially that my wife shall have
the use of Nancy and Oriskany, during her life time,
and I direct that at the death of my wife that
all the property in her possession shall be equally
divided amongst my children including the land
on which she lived, as well as personal property which
she had and I do empower my executors to make
full and lawful conveyances of all my lands, which
they may sell under this will. And lastly I appoint
my friends Charles Smith, Peter Smith and Jacob Key
my executors to this my last will and Testament.
