and bequeath this my last will and Testament touching
such worldly Estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless
me with in this his last will and desire and dispose of the same
in the following manner to wit

First I give and bequeath to Hannah my dearly beloved wife
and Uriah my son all my household goods money and
moveable effects. I then bequeath to my said son Uriah
Humble my two hundred acres of Land lying in Rocking
Creek and one hundred acres of Land that then now lying on
after the decease of my wife Hannah she having full possession
of the same, also I give and bequeath to my son
Uriah my two hundred acres of Land that he is now living
on, also I give and bequeath to John Fitzwater my
son my two hundred acres of Land that he is now
living on, also I give and bequeath to Richard Custer my
son two hundred and fifty acres of Land situate
between Creeks Jefferson Clinton District of Kentucky
I also give and bequeath to my Daughter Rachel Two hundred
and fifty acres of Land adjoining said Richd Custer on Clear Creek
County of District aforesaid, I do also empower my brother
Elizabeth Humble my true attorney to make a deed of

Conveyance for eight hundred and twenty five acres of Land
lying about fourteen miles below the mouth of Kentucky river
on the banks of the Ohio to James Johnston my brother in
law for and in my name the entry being for Twelve hundred
and Twenty five acres between said Johnston and myself the
above mentioned part falling to his share, I also give and bequeath
all the remainder of my lands to the above Legatee viz Roath
Uriah & Rachel Humble my wife Hannah, John Fitzwater
and Richard Custer each of them being an equal share of
expenses of clearing it out of the Office & each Legatee receiving
an equal share thereof. I also constitute make & assign Han
nah my dearly beloved wife the whole & sole executrix of this my
last will and Testament and I do hereby utterly disavow and
disannul all and every other former Testaments wills and
bequests Legacies requests and acts by me in any manner be
fore named written a bequeathed Ratifying & confirming this &
no other to be my last will & Testament in Witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand & face this Tenth day of January
One thousand seven hundred & Ninety One
