funeral expenses) shall be and re-
main in the hands of my beloved
wife Michael Ruby during her nat-
ural life for the support of herself
and my four youngest children

and at her death it is my desire that
the whole shall be sold and equally di-
vided amongst all my children
except my four youngest it is my de-
sire that each of them shall have
ten pounds extraordinary)
