In the name of God Amen, I, Jacob Jones, of the County of Lancaster and State of Virginia, being weak in body, but of sound memory, blessed be God, do this 28 day of September 1795 make and publish this my Last Will and Testament in manner following that is to say first I give and bequeath to my wife below named Eleanor Brown one cow now in possession of her son Thomas and all the remainder of my estate that I am now endowed with I give & bequeath to my wife below and trusty friend John Brown and his heirs and assigns him my said friend John Brown of the county and state aforesaid my sole executor of this my Last Will & Testament in full for the intent and purpose in this my will contained and to take and see the same performed according to my true intent and meaning. In testimony whereof I the said Jacob Jones have to this my Last Will and Testament set my hand and seal the day and year above written.
