I Dec'd of Gift Sep: 6. 1790 to all people to whom
these presents shall come, I Jacob Moore do send
know ye that I the said Moore of the parish of
in the County of Bourbon for and in consideration of
true Good Will and Affection which I have and do bear
towards my Loving Wives, Nancy Tunk Eliz Alkire
of the same parish and County, I have given & granted
and by these presents do fully give & grant unto the
said Nancy Tunk & Eliz Alkire their heirs & assigns
or assigns all and singular my Goods & Chattels
now being in my hands in the Parish aforesaid known
by the of which before the signing of these presents I have
delivered her the said Nancy Tunk Eliz Alkire
and Philip Moore do give them and upon the
Union of the County of Hardy on the South side

and Inventory signed with my own hand and
the Bond of Union is one hundred and Eighty
Pounds this to be divided between Nancy Tunk
Eliza both Alkire and Philip Moore this my
Last will and Testament where hereunto I set my
hand and seal this Sixth day Septemr 1790
