being very sick and weak in body but of perfect
mind and memory thanks be given unto God
calling unto mind the mortality of my body and
knowing that it is appointed for all men once
to die do make and ordain this my last Will
and Testamen^t that is to say principally and first

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first of all I give and recommend my soul
into the hand of Almighty God that gave it
and my body I recommend to the earth to be
buried in decent Christian burial at the dis-
cretion of my executors nothing doubting but
at the general Resurrection I shall receive the
same again by the mighty Power of God. And
as touching such worldly estate wherewith it
has pleased God to bless me in this life I give
devise, and dispose of the same in the following
manner and form. *Imprimis*. All my debts of
which there are but few and none of magnitude
are to be punctually and speedily paid by my
executors herein after mentioned. *Item* To my
dearly beloved wife Peggy Bell I give and be-
queath all my stock of beasts or creatures of whatsoev-
er name or kind they may be together with my
household and kitchen furniture to be possessed
and fully enjoyed by her and her heirs forever.
Item. I give and bequeath to my dearly beloved
wife the plantation on which I now live together with
the appertinances thereunto belonging to be freely poss-
essed and enjoyed by her during her widowhood or
so long as she remains unmarried. After her marriage
or after her decease during her widowhood in either
case I give and bequeath the plantation on which I
now reside to my brother Thomas Bell with its
appertinances to be freely possessed and enjoyed by
him and his heirs forever. I constitute make and
ordain Julius Clarkson and Alexander McPheters my

my worthy friends and executors of this my last will and testament. And I do hereby utterly disavow revoke and disannul all and every other former Testaments Will legacies bequests and executors by me in any ways before named willed and bequeathed ratifying and confirming this to be my last will and Testament.
