In the name of God Amen. Know, I Robert Clifford of the County of Portland and Commonwealth of Virginia, being ill of Health and weak of body, solemnly not in ability of recovery but thoroughly God aware beholding my perfect senses and memory, to therefore institute this is my last will and testament, this making mine all other wills by me formerly made. I do therefore recommend my soul to God who guideth and my body to the grave to interred in whatever manner and place he shall see fit and personal estate I do give bequeath in manner shown following To wit

That my will and desire is that all my Just & Lawful debts be paid then all the rest of my estate, is give and bequeath to all my Brothers & Sisters to be equally divided between them, except one share I bequeath to my Brother James Clifford and one share which is at home to his wife I give unto my sister Jane Clifford more than their Equal parts, but it is my will that my brother James Clifford and Mr. Miller be sole Executors and to see and singulate of this my last will and therefore I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 13 day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand seven and ninety and in the presence of

July Court 1791, The Last will & testament of Rob. Clifford was proved by James Clifford his second witness there to & ordered to be recorded, and Mr. Miller Esq. then in court came into Court and qualified as a Justice of the Peace, and with Mr. Gullett & James Wright his associates gave Bond under seal of \$1000 Conditioned as the Law requires, & Clifford is granted himself for obtaining probate thereof in due form
