

five equal parts - if the value of said lands in Butler shall equal or exceed three thirds of the aforesaid rate an order to be made in Doulton of my said son, then my said sons John and Tho. shall not receive any part of the rate in Doulton nor shall they be compelled to fall short of two thirds of the rate made in Doulton, my said sons John and Tho. shall receive so much of the purchase money of the Doulton lands as will make them equal to two thirds of the Butler or two fifths of the whole value of the said two tracts, and the amount of the purchase money in Doulton shall be divided between my said sons, Abt. Jps and Joseph, and if the value of the Butler lands shall exceed or equal two thirds of the value of the Doulton lands may be sold, then the whole price of the said lands shall be equal to be divided between my said three sons Abt. Jps and Joseph. - I hereby appoint my wife Sarah and my eldest son Joseph Executors of this my last will and testament and charge them with the due execution thereof. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 11th day of May 1791.
