bon and State of Kentucky being in
a low state of health but of perfect
mind and memory and reflecting to
mind the mortality of my body and
knowing that it is appointed for all
men once to dye do make and or-
dain this my last Will and Tes-
tament that is to say I Will that
all my just debts be justly dischar-
ged by my executors hereafter na-

med and I give and bequeath
unto John Barns my wife the one
half of all my money and person-
al property to be appraised & sold
and the other half I give & bequeath
unto my daughter: My and I ap-
point J. M. Smith & J. W. Brown
my executors to see that my last
Will and Testament be performed
empowering them to pay out &
dispose of the bequest and take re-
ceipts for the same. In Witness
I have hereunto set my hand &
Seal this 20th day of April 1808
