In the name of God, Amen. I Joshua Rowlings of the County of Bourbon and State of Kentucky being weak in body, but in perfect mind and memory and calling to mind the mortality of all men that were all born, once to die, do therefore devise and Ordain this my last will and Testament, and first of all I recommend my body to the dust from whence it came to be inters at the discretion of my Executors and my soul into the hands of the Almighty who gave it, and as to the worldly estate I have in this world to bestow on me, I do hereby bequeath it in the following manner, to wit, I give and bequeath unto my well beloved daughter, Susannah, my son Lory and daughter Anna the farm wherein I now dwell containing fifty acres with its appurtenances. It is also my desire that my widow should reside on this farm until the eldest child comes of age, if she chooses otherwise, or, to leave it, in that case I desire the farm to be sold by the Executors, and the money arising therefrom to be put to an Interest for the use of the of Susannah, Lory and Anna. It is further my desire that my son Lory should be put apprentice to the Saddle Business under the direction of my Executors, and also if it should so happen that my widow should marry again, in that case I wish the plantation to be put into the hands of my Executors and at all times be subject to their care as to waste of Timber or other depredations. It is also my desire that each of the above children should be Educated out of a part of my estate hereafter to be mentioned.

I now I give and bequeath unto my well beloved wife Sophia One third part of a tract of Land lying on the waters of Holts creek part of a preemption of John Canady's deceased containing one hundred and thirty acres also one third part of a tract of land lying on the waters of

Waters of Elkhorn and Eagle Creek enters in the names of said Canary - the
 One Negro man names Joseph which said Negro is now deemed a slave
 during life or the natural life of the said Sophia, but if the said Sophia
 should hereafter happen to marry, in that case the said Joseph shall not
 be in bondage to a second Husband, but shall be in the Power of said
 Sophia to emancipate him at her pleasure or otherwise to will him
 to her children, if she so thinks proper, Item, I give and bequeath
 unto my well beloved children Luby, Darcas and Lee my last
 wifes children an equal part the aforesaid two tracts of land of
 which One third as aforementioned I give and bequeath to my wife,
 the remaining two thirds shall be equally divided between the aforesaid Luby
 Darcas and Lee, as to my moveable estate I desire it should be appraised
 or sold, and after my debts are paid and expences of Funeral, and
 what may be sufficient for schooling my children the remainder
 part (if any) to be equally divided between the above mentioned Legatee.

I do hereby nominate and appoint Thomas Darnall, William
 Torman Sophia Rawlings and Nicholas Talbot my Executors, the said
 Darnall and Torman to Act for the first mentioned three children
 the last mentioned Sophia and Nicholas for the three last mentioned chil-
 dren, I do further certify that to be my last will and Testament hereby
 revoking and disannulling all former wills and Testaments whatever
 In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed
 my seal this 25 day of August One thousand eight hundred and one
