Pursuant to an order of the worshipful Court of Bourbon County, appointing us the undersigned commissioners to examine, state and settle with Thomas Kennedy the accounts of his guardianship of the estates of Joseph, Jacob, Sophia, Nathan and Rebecca Kennedy, infant orphans of Joseph Kennedy dec'd. We thereupon met at the dwelling house of the said Thomas Kennedy on the 9th day of March 1807 and being first duly sworn we proceeded to examine the accounts aforesaid and upon settling all accounts to us produced, we make the following statement To wit: 1st We find due to Joseph Kennedy including the inventory of his estate laid in by his said Guardian together with his share of the hire of slaves a principal of
