my desire that all the household and kitchen
furniture shall be kept and used for the
use of the family my negro girl Mary also
shall be kept for the purpose of assisting and
maintaining the family my negro girl Ellen
shall be sold for 1000

to you and the money arising therefrom
and from the sales of the stock shall be paid
over at Interest and remain until my
children shall come of age and among them
be equally divided amongst my children
except my daughter Sissy she being more
weakly than the rest it is my desire ^{that} she
may have one hundred dollars extraordi-

nan. ^{Item} It is my desire that when my young-
est children of age or marriages that my
negatives may be sold and the money and
any from the whole of my estate after paying
my just debts to be divided equally to the
my last will and testament bequeath
my children and my wife giving to her
a full and early settlement
appoint John Field my executor & exe-
cutor to carry this my last will and
