We also find in the hands of the Administrator for aforesaid a bond executed by Joseph Pittier and William Graves to John Graves Trustee of Richard Graves for 252 lbs 10 dated 29th November 1806 and made payable on demand all of which bond appears by Credit Indorsed thereon to \$11.7.8 yet due.

Also one \$^o executed by Thomas Graves to John Graves Trustee as aforesaid for four hundred and twenty dollars dated 23rd November 1807 and made payable on demand on which there appears no Credit.

Also one small note executed by Thomas Graves to William Arnell for three dollars dated 25th Nov 1807 & made payable on demand.

Also \$183 worth of property which had been given in the lifetime of Richard Graves to his four eldest children which could not be come at the time of sale the amount of which we charge the Administrator aforesaid.

We also find in the hands of Administrator and not charged above the following sums of money owing for the hire of slaves belonging to the Estate of Richard Graves dec^d for the year 1810 & 1811 for the year 1810.

Ans for 1811

Also in the hands of the Administrator for one year rent of the farm

Credit the Administrator aforesaid by \$40 for necessary repairs done on said farm

This subtracted from the above rent leaves ten dollars of the last rent yet due.

Credit the Administrator aforesaid by \$133 money spent on two journeys to Virginia & back on the business of the estate aforesaid.
