Item I do loan all my Estate both real and personal to my beloved wife Elizabeth so long as she remains a widow and at her death or marriage I would wish my Estate both real and personal to be divided equally amongst the remainder of my children to wit George White Catharine White Sarah White Betsy White Robert White Nancy White Tho if either of my above mentioned children die leaving no lawful issue it is my wish their portion to return to my Estate and be equally divided amongst the survivors Tho if ~~any~~ ^{either} of my above named children

be dead leaving lawful heirs it is my wish that they stand in their ^{rights} shares and divide their portion equally among them and lastly it is my desire that George White and William be my executors.
