This last will and testament of Thomas Kirby deceased was proved by the Oaths of John M Allen and John Kiger subscribing witnesses thereto and Ordered to be recorded. Whereupon John Kiger and Nancy Kirby Executors named in said will came into Court and made oath thereto and together with John Kiger Senior and Edmond Keeney their securities entered into and Acknowledged their bond in the penalty of \$1000. Conditioned as the law directs Certificate is granted them for obtaining a probate thereof in due form of law.
