I John Fuld Senr, being in a low state of health and being desirous to make this my last will and testament and wish to dispose of my property in the following manner, that is to say, by my Wife Diannah Fuld the following negroes Brecken, Bartlett, Zachariah and Selah, and also the household and kitchen furniture and my crop, excepting the hemp and when my wife Diannah Fuld shall leave this world, the above specified property to be equally divided among all my Children excepting my son Henry Fuld and my daughter Nancy Morrow, my other negroes to be divided in the following manner, to my son Gust Fuld Perry and Lewis to my daughter Judah Fuld Wade and Betty, to my daughter Lucinda Fuld baby and Thomas and I do also devise and leave in the power of my daughter Ester and her heirs for the benefit and use of my daughter Nancy Morrow and at her death to be equally divided amongst her living Children, my
