 I Give & bequeath to my third son Nicholas Lewis one
 Dollar and seventhly I Give & Bequeath unto my Daugh-
 -ter Ann McCreary one Dollar & eighthly I Give & Bequeath
 to my youngest son James Lewis the Remainder of my
 Estate after my lawful Debts being Paid I Do hereby
 make my son James Lewis heir & Executor of all my es-
 -tate both Real & Personal except as above excepted
 Nullifying all former wills & bequeaths by me made but
 Ratifying & acknowledging this to be my last will &
 Testament signed with my hand & Sealed with my seal
 the Day & Date above Written
