The balance in the hands of the Administrators is \$792.26 1/2 Cents, exclusive of a bond on Samuel Glaprock amounting to \$166.66 Cents which is supposed to be lost by Glaprock's being insolvent.

It appears to the Commissioners that there are Accounts against the Estate unsettled to the amount of \$240 or upward, with the costs of several suits now depending & undetermined, which they think proper with the addition of \$30 for probable costs and expenditures, to leave in the hands of the Administrators, for future adjustment; which leaves a sum of \$522.26 1/2 Cents for distribution.
