

19 The last will and Testament of Thomas Sence age about twenty nine years of age are as follow (to wit) being in perfect strength of memory and judgment and calling to mind the Certainty of Death do hereby Bequeath my Soul to God who gave it and my body to be Buried in a Christian Manner by my Survivors and the Charges arising thereby with all my just Debts to be Discharged of the hole of what Estate God hath Blessed me with, I Leave to my loving wife fifty five Pounds and the Interest of said bond which is Due me from Wm McFar the sixth Day of December, I also allow her one horse brature and choice of two Cows & Calves out of My Stock, her Saddle bed bedclothes & body clothes Putter and Spinning wheel also the half of my Crop of Corn and all my flax also her Choice of two of my hogs and what Remains after My beloved wife's Legacy is paid off, of my Cows Sheep and hogs & all my other articles such as Iron tools Castings and the like also one lot of one forth of a acre in the town at the forks of Licking to be sold at Publick Sale to Discharge my lawfull Debts and I allow Each of My Nephews a suit of Cloths at the Discretion of my Executors to purchase as the see fitt and If any things Remains after that is then with one lot of one forth of a acre of ground at the forks of Licking I also Bequeath to my beloved wife,

220 I also leave two suits of Cloths to my Brother Samuel Sence but be it Remembred it is ~~that~~ I have. Now in presence I also leave Brother Robert. My blue coat and fracoat I Do appoint and ordain. My Wife. Executor of this last will and Testament Revoking all other wills by me made heretofore. Signed with My Name and Sealed this Nineteenth Day of September one thousand seven hundred and Ninety five
