

Joseph Robinson and Willson Alexander declared
 that they were both present at the time that
 Nathan Trakes departed this life and that
 the said Nathan in the morning of the same
 day on which he died (he then being of sound
 mind) called on them the said Joseph
 Robinson and Willson Alexander to take
 notice in what manner he then desired and
 wished his estate to be disposed of which they
 declare was in the following manner
 To wit that the said Nathan Trakes was to
 have fifty acres of the tract of land on
 which he then resided to include the
 Improvement and plantation ^{whereon} Willson
 Alexander now lives together with one
 Shovel, plough and Lye pot and the bed
 and furniture on which the said then lay
 the bed and furniture was given on the
 condition ^{dictum} ~~condition~~ ^{dictum} that he the said Nathan
 married and went to home keeping to his
 Son John Trakes he gave the residue
 of the tract of land on which he
 then lived together with all his other
 property which he then possessed of all
 kinds and description whatever declaring
 all his other children had been provided
 for in his will whereby the said
 Joseph Robinson and Willson Alexander
 set their hands and seals this 22nd day of
 Sept 1817
