

The Will of Jane B. Ramsey of Danville Ky
 1st I revoke all wills heretofore made by me
 2nd I bequeath to Mary St Clair Lynd two thousand Dollars to Mary Rout Mrs Caroline Douglas Mrs Jane Rutherford Mr Francis G Craft each one thousand dollars and to John B. Young William Young Eugenia Young Billa Young Sally The Young and George B Young each five hundred Dollars
 3rd I bequeath to the secretaries for the time being of the foreign & Home Missionary Societies of the Presbyterian Church of United States each the sum of two hundred dollars to be by them severally held & used for the benefit of said Societies

4th After the payment of these legacies and bequests I bequeath & devise the residue of my estate real & personal & mixed to Mrs Jane Rutherford to be by her held & used as her separate estate free from the controul of her husband or any she may have & with full power & authority to dispose of & convey the same by deed will or personal gift evidenced by writing as if she were an unmarried woman

5th I appoint Allan H Rout the executor of my estate & request that no security be required of him & him in his official bond

The will of William Owsley

I William Owsley make and proclaim this to be my last will and testament

1st I bequeath to my daughter Amanda Rodes - Elizabeth Talbot and Almira Goodloe each the sum of fourteen thousand Dollars of which six thousand Dollars is to be paid to each of my said daughters in bank stock at par value the balance in cash all of which thus bequeathed is to be held by the said daughters severally as their own separate estate - free from the controul of their husbands with full power on the part of my said Daughter to dispose of the same by will or otherwise as fully as if they were

2nd I bequeath to the descendants of my daughter Ann-elia Anderson the like sum of fourteen thousand Dollars to be paid in like manner as above described six thousand Dollars in Bank Stock at par and the balance in cash all to be divided as follows - one equal fourth thereof to each of the following Mrs Elizabeth Boyle Mrs Margaret Watts and Mrs Ida Roland which is devised to them to be by them held and used as their own separate estate free from the controul of their husbands and with full power to each to dispose of the same by will or otherwise as each may deem proper the other fourth of the last named fourteen thousand Dollars is to be equally divided between the children of William B Anderson decd to wit: Elisabeth Clifton and William

3rd I bequeath to each and every one of my grandchildren that is children of my children one hundred Dollars except Amanda Craig & William son of E B Owsley to whom I bequeath each three hundred Dollars and also except Will. C. Talbot whose note I hold for one hundred and fifty dollars which note I bequeath to him in place of the hundred Dollars bequeathed to my other grandchildren - the three hundred dollars which is thus bequeathed to Amanda Craig is to be deducted from the bequest to her Mother Almira Goodloe and to that extent the bequest to her Mother is lessened

4th To the children of W C Anderson in addition to the bequest made above I bequeath to each one hundred Dollars and fifty Dollars

5th I bequeath to my daughter Amanda Rodes
