between them out of the first money collected of my estate after my death.

Item 2^d I give and bequeath unto my grand daughter Jane Byers and her four children Sarah Elizabeth Byers, Horiet Ellen Byers, John Christopher Byers & James Thomas Byers the residue of estate after my death to be divided equally and all made equal

Item 3^d. It is my will and desire after my death that my Executor herein after named sell all my property and out of the proceeds of the sale and moneys he pay all my just debts and the remainder to belong to and be paid as above directed.

Item 4th I appoint my nephew J. Goodnight my Executor to carry into effect the provisions of this will as witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this the 11th day of August 1858
