2nd I desire that as soon after my death as my ~~Exec~~ ^{Exec} herein named seems right & proper that he sell all of my real & personal property of every kind on such terms & credits as he may think best, hereby investing him with full power and authority to sell and convey my Real estate by deed to the purchaser or purchasers

3rd After the payment of my debts and funeral expenses and the cost of Administration I will the residue of my estate to N. W. Fields, S. W. Fields, Sarah C. Wright, Susan R. Dumlaf & the children of my daughter Polly, M. Durham deceased formerly the wife of John Durham. That one fifth to Wm Fields one fifth to Sam Fields one fifth to Susan Dumlaf from & from the contract of her husband and one fifth to Sarah C. Wright & one fifth to the children of my deceased daughter Polly, M. Durham

I hereby nominate and appoint M. J. Durham the Exr of this my last will & testament investing him with full power to collect my cash notes, sell and dispose of my property as herein directed & to divide the sum as herein provided & to fully execute this will.
