

I, Aquilla Gilbert of Breckinridge County in the State of Kentucky, being of sound mind and memory, and knowing the uncertainty of time, and the certainty of death, I hereby make the following Will. After my just debts and funeral expenses are paid, then I will sell my personal estate, cattle and sheep, and household and kitchen furniture to Rachel Gilbert my lawful Wife. And for her further support I leave her the place or tract of land where I live containing One hundred acres, and also Ten acres to be added to it, forming a sixty eight acre tract of land which I now own all of which she is to hold during the term of her natural life. And my will is further that by my son George Gilbert taking care of and providing for his Mother Rachel Gilbert during her life he is to have full benefit of the said land.

And should he survive his Mother the full right and title to said land is then vested in him. My son George Gilbert

The balance of my sixty eight acre tract of land after taking off the ten acres above mentioned, I will to my two Daughters, Phelps Maysey and Laura Bassett, to be divided equally between them. This being my last Will and Testament, I hereby revoke all others here before made by me.
