I Dade Bonner of Breckenridge County and State of Kentucky being weak in body but of sound mind and disposing memory do make this my last will and Testament Revoking all wills heretofore made first of all I give my soul into the hands of Almighty God who give and body to be buried in a decent manner at the discretion of my executors but as touching ^{worldly} estate which God has blessed me with in this life I give and dispose of in the following manner and form

first it is my wish that all my Just debts should be paid if any

second I give & bequeath to my beloved wife Sidney Bonner and my daughter Lidie Bonner the farm I now live on and all my personal property of all kinds during my wifes Life-time

Third I give & bequeath to my daughter Mary Lang two hundred dollars at the death of my wife or sooner if my executors sell the the farm

fourth I give & bequeath to my son Lewis Bonner two hundred dollars at the Death of my wifes death or sooner if my executors sell the farm

fifth I give & bequeath to my daughter Sarah Miller two hundred dollars at the death of my wife or sooner if my ~~Executors~~ Executors sell the farm

sixth I give & bequeath to my Grand daughter Sarah Margaret Lapwell a daughter of my Daughter Seneth Lapwell who is dead and if she dies before she becomes of age to be given to her two Brothers William Jasper & Francis Marion Lapwell fifty dollars at the Death of my wife or sooner if the farm is sold the money to be put out at Interest untill she or they become of lawful age

seventh I give & bequeath to my son Washington Bonners children my Grand children Isable Bonner Dade Franklin Bonner & Hamilton Bonner one hundred Dollars to be equally divided between them at the death of my wife or sooner if the farm is sold

eighth I give and bequeath to my son Benjamin Bonner two hundred dollars at the death of wife or sooner if the farm is sold

ninth I give & bequeath to my son Charles Bonner two hundred dollars at the death of my wife or sooner if the farm is sold

I Give & bequeath to my daughter Lydia bennor four feather beds three bedsteads and all the bed clothing that belongs to the four beds one cupboard and all the cupboard were the by Dining table & the Bureau and if the ~~farm~~ ^{farm} is sold before the Death of my wife Then my wife & my daughter Lydia bennor to have after the legacies are all paid of the balance of what is Left is to be equally Divided between them to do as pleas with and if the farm is not sold before my wife's Death then after paying of the foregoing legacies my daughter Lydia have all the balance of my estate I also appoint James bunningham my wife & my daughter Lydia Executors to carry out this my Last will also it is my desire that my executors sell the farm if they can but a fair price and I authorize my executor James bunningham to convey the same if they sell the land Given under my hand and seal this 23rd day of September 1856

Examined In the name of God I William Keaton of the County of Breckenridge and State of Kentucky knowing the certainty of death and the time it may happen and for the purpose of settling my worldly affairs do make and ordain this my last will and Testament as follows viz

My desire is that my just debts and funeral charges be first paid Then give and bequeath to my beloved wife Mary Ann during her lifetime or widowhood all of My Estate both real and personal without any interruption at her death to return to my children to be equally divided between them I constitute and appoint my wife Mary Ann Keaton Executrix free from security or surety to this my last will and Testament revoking all others by me hereafter made and I further bequeath to my son James R Keaton all that tract or parcels of land conveyed by Thomas Lowry to me containing one hundred and three acres with the provision that James R Keaton pay
