 property to which my two youngest children are entitled my eldest children with regard
 to the property that I have given them that property shall be and bequeath to her children
 or during her widowhood and if her estate in consequence of a debt of twenty
 dollars shall be sold as I have at this time to be paid some and which I am sure will be paid
 I desire that each of my other heirs shall receive of my estate twenty dollars and
 after that I will and bequeath to all my children and their heirs, for ever
 an equal portion of my ^{remaining} estate both personal & real.
 Now be it further known that I desire that there shall be no mention made or regard
 but that my wife by the advice of her friends shall manage the estate and have
 authority in consequence of this being my last will and testament. I do hereby
 affirm my hand and seal

I David Garret of the County of Buchanan and State of Kentucky
 being of sound mind and disposing memory that of such and parties being
 do make constitute and ordain this my last will and testament, to wit, that
 it is my will & desire that all my just debts be paid & it is my will and desire
 that my wife Maria have and hold of all the real and personal property I
 possess during her life that she have all the kitchen and household furniture
 now on the place and that she have all the money I have in possession being
 about \$80 for the purpose of providing clothes and shoes for the family
 & I will and bequeath to my son Richard Garret one sixth part of my property
 which remains after the bequest to my wife Maria upon deducting from his part
 one \$50. being the value of a horse I gave him - 3^d I will and bequeath to
 William Brundoff the one sixth part of my estate after taken out the portion
 given to my wife as aforesaid and deducting from this bequest \$100 the
 value of a negro girl given to my daughter Elizabeth Fisher and \$75 being the
 value of a mare & \$25 being the value of a cow advanced to the said
 Elizabeth Fisher but this bequest is made upon the express condition and trust that
 the portion of my property which the said William Brundoff shall receive herefrom
 shall be held by him for the use and benefit of my said daughter Elizabeth & that the
 said Brundoff shall allow the said Elizabeth to have use and enjoy the possession
 & profits of said property and it her estate that the said property prop and land
 to her heirs it is my will and desire that the said William Brundoff have the
 negro girl Maria and her child that upon the condition and trust that the
 said Brundoff hold the said slaves for the use and benefit of my said
 daughter and that he allow her to have use and enjoy the possession of said slaves

and it her death that they pass and come to the heirs of the said Edgworth
It is my Will and desire that my said Robert have and live of my
property remaining after the bequest to him and in default of the value of a
house amount to him &c. It is my Will and desire that my children Thomas
William and Julia have each one sixth part of my property remaining after taken
out my wife's portion. It is my Will and desire that my Negroes be hired out
yearly on the 1st day of January for 4 years except my negro woman Julia and her
child it is my wish that she remain with my wife Julia and that her yearly
hire be valued by two disinterested persons one appointed by my wife Julia and
the other by my executor here in after appointed & the proceeds of the hire be divided
one third to my wife Julia and the residue among my children equally &c.
and at the expiration of the term of hiring aforesaid it is my Will
and desire that said slaves be divided among my wife and children
according to the several bequest to them to be set forth said divisions to be
made by 3 disinterested men appointed by my Executor.

7th It is my Will and desire that all the residue of my personal property
not herein before disposed of shall remain on my farm until the 1st of January
and then be sold by my Executor on such terms as he may think best and ad-
vantageous and the proceeds be divided in like manner with the property bequeathed.

8th I nominate and appoint John McWhorter to be the Executor of
this my last Will and Testament Witness my hand &c. at this 25th day of July
1848.
