

This is the last will and Testament of Mr. Edward D. Burton of
Examined. Breckinridge County, State of Kentucky, Farmer.

1. After the payment of my just debts and funeral expenses, out of whatever personal estate I may have, the remainder of my personalty, if any, shall be divided equally among my heirs.
2. And having in my life time made an equal distribution of my landed estate amongst my children, to wit, to Geo. Burton the proceeds of a tract of land which I sold in Grayson County to one Roberts for \$75.00 with other money, & the rents and taxes on the land for several years,
3. To Sarah Clemens, I have advanced & conveyed to her a tract of land of about 100 acres, on the 23^d day of April 1880,
4. To Allen M. Burton, I have advanced and conveyed to him, a tract of land of about 90 acres on the 23^d day of April 1880 lying and being in Grayson County,
5. To Josephine Clemens I have advanced, by paying for it, the tract of land on which she now resides & which the Clemens purchased of George Keare,
6. To Laura A. Hilder I have advanced ^(I conveyed) to her, a tract of land of about 100 acres, on the 23^d day of April 1880
7. To Edward D. Burton, I have advanced and conveyed to him a tract of land, of inv. 236 acres, on the 23^d day of April 1880 containing certain agreements and stipulations, all of which, it is my will, shall be faithfully carried out.
8. To Etton M. Burton, I have advanced and conveyed to him a tract of land of about 100 acres, on the 23^d day of April 1880
9. I have thus divided all my property, landed estate, as near as I well could on the principle of Equality, between my children, without taking into consideration whatever of small advancements I have made to each, whether of money or property, during my life. And it is now my will and desire, that these advancements shall be final, and conclusive, without controversy or litigation.

And I appoint James G. Harnell, sole Executor of this my will hereby revoking all other wills made by me at any time here before.
