

I, Felix Bearin of the County of Breckinridge and State of Kentucky of Sound and disposing mind and Memory and being desirous of settling my worldly affairs while I have strength and capacity do to do - do make and publish my last Will and Testament. That is to say 1st I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Lucia Bearin One third of all of my real and personal property to have and to hold during her natural life 2^d The balance of all my property both real and personal I give and bequeath to all my beloved children to be equally divided into the following portions 1st I do will and direct that my beloved daughter Elizabeth S. Barkin shall receive and have her Part of Said Estate payed to her in person which shall be for the Special Benefit of herself and children - and not to be put in the hands of her Husband Wesley Barkin - I do furthermore will and direct that in case my daughter Margaret S. Bearin shall at any time marry Nathaniel Beale - she shall have but one dollar out of all of my property and no more
