

This is the last will and testament of me Hannah
Dasham of Breckinridge County Ky

1 After paying my just debts and funeral
expenses out of whatever personal estate I may have the re-
mainder of my personalty if any shall be divided equally
among my only living heirs Mary & Seaton and Obediah
Dasham except that I have advanced to my said daughter
two beds (feather) and one bedstead and clothing or
bedding and if I do not give him these or their equi-
valent in my life time then he is to have them out of
my personal estate to make him equal with her.

2 And whereas I own two tracts of land in
this County and Circuit me on the North Fork of Rough
Creek of about 152 acres whereon Skillman Urnes now
resides and one tract on Daniels Creek where I now reside
of about 126 acres more or less which I desire shall be
equally divided between my two heirs aforesaid if the
division can be equitably made if not my desire ~~is~~
is that the same shall be sold and the proceeds equally
divided between them.

3 And whilst I may have confidence in the
honor and integrity of my son in law Emmett J Seaton
yet I have grave doubts as to his management and
ability to keep what he may get hence it is my will
and desire that all the property hereby devised to my said
daughter Mary both real and personal is to Vest in her
and in her heirs whether by Seaton or another, equally,
after her death But in order to protect her and her said
heirs in whatever property I may die seized & possessed of
it is my will that my executor hereafter appointed shall
make such title to her and her heirs aforesaid as shall
fully prevent her said husband from making any disposition
of the estate so devised whatever or from committing any
waste thereon or any use thereof to the detriment of said
Mary or her heirs but that the same shall be held
for their sole use and benefit forever.

4 And I appoint J P Owen sole executor
of this my will with power to make conveyances if
such should be needed or to make distribution of any
~~land~~ as prescribed by by this my will hereby revoking
all other wills made by me at any time heretofore.
