

I Hermann Lueckhardt of the County of Breckinridge and State of Kentucky being in full health but of sound and disposing memory do make this my last will and testament hereby revoking all former last wills by me made First It is my will and desire that all of my debts be fully paid and satisfied immediately after my death Secondly It is my will and desire that all my property both real and personal of whatsoever kind or description at my decease descend to my beloved wife Metildia C Lueckhardt to be under her exclusive control and management to be disposed of as she may in her best judgment decide with full power to convey by deed or other lawfull manner to the purchaser or purchasers This is to have our four children to wit Hermann C Lueckhardt Ida J. Lueckhardt & Minna Lueckhardt and Margaret C Lueckhardt under her protection and care and they are to be maintained & educated by her in a comfortable and economical manner and the expenses thereof to be paid out of profits arising or out of said estate Thirdly I hereby appoint my beloved wife Metildia C Lueckhardt my executrix to carry into effect the provisions of this my last will and testament and I request that the Court do not require security of her In testimony of which I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal on this twenty eighth day of October A.D. 1864 Signed Sealed and published in the presence of Hermann Lueckhardt
