

I Leah Heston of the County of Brunswick and State
of Kentucky do make and publish this my last will and
testament first I have heretofore advanced to my son
Selas Heston at various times money and property
which with my my own saddle which I hereby give to
him I value at \$500
Second I have heretofore ^{given} to my daughter Mary Pullin one
negro woman dolly which I value at \$200 and I hereby
give to her my negro woman Rachel which I value at
\$200 making \$700
And I give and devise to my wife Ellen Heston all my stock
household and kitchen furniture & farming implements of
every kind they being principally hers at the time of our
marriage and also such property of the present crop as
may be necessary for the support of the family for 12
months from the time of my decease
4th The cash notes & other effects and property which I own
here negroes I wish applied to the payment of my debts
5 I direct that the vendor of my negroes not heretofore
given or devised shall be hired out for the term of
three years the hiring to take place on the 1st day of
January after my decease they they remaining on the
farm in the mean time the ~~proceeds~~ proceeds of the
hire to be applied to gather with other effects
above named to the payment of my debts and the
support of my infant children Sela Myra
6th after the expiration of the 3 years hiring of the
slaves if any thing should remain of the proceeds of hire
or of my other effects after my debts are paid the same
is to constitute a fund for equipping my children Sela
& Myra with my other who have been advanced as above shall
that is to say to give Myra & Sela each \$300 should said
fund be insufficient to make them equal then they are
to be made equal out of the slaves either in the division
of the slaves if a division can be made in kind if not
out of the proceeds of the sale of the slaves and
then after they are then equalized the rest and residue
of my estate to be equally divided between my four
children Mary Pullin Selas Heston Sela Heston &
Myra Heston my Executor hereinafter named is author-
ized to make the division of the slaves as above direct-
ed or if not susceptible of division to sell them or
such of them as he may deem necessary
I hereby nominate and appoint my wife Ellen
and my son in Law Richard Pullin as executors
and administrators of this my last will & testament in
testimony whereof I hereby subscribe my name in
hand this 19 May 1864

I make this Codicil to the above will upon reflection
 I think the here of the Slaves now remaining will not
 be answer all the purpose I desire if hired out for
 three years as directed. I therefore direct that they be
 hired out for the term of five years in stead of three
 and hereby make this Change in my will in all other respec-
 ts the will previously made is to stand as my will and
 I hereby republish the same together with this
 Codicil November 15 1864

 the uncertainty of life, being of sound mind
 and disposing memory, hereby make an &
 ordain this my last will and Testament, hereby
 revoking and making void all others, that have
 been made by me
 First, Having given to each of my children who
 have married and left me, money or its equiv-
 alent to the amount of One hundred dollars,
 also one bed and bedding, One cow and calf
 and One head of sheep, I will that my two
 children who live yet with me, viz. Moses and
 Emily have each the same amount and in
 addition one Saddle and Bridle to the value of
 Eighteen dollars, and in addition that my
 two youngest children, viz. Moses and Emily
 shall have the privilege of going to school
 twelve months to be paid for out of my estate
 and also will that my wife Francis Ray
