County Court Monday September 11th 1854

The above foregoing Writing purporting to be the last Will & Testament of Abdiash Newman do^u now exhibited in Court and thereupon David M. Murray Ezekiel Fisher John E. Martin John W. Raith & Robert L. Newcom came into Court and and solemnly swore that they were well acquainted with the hand Writing of Abdiash Newman and that they had frequently saw him write and that they truly believed that the whole of the writing signature & all was in the hand Writing of the said Abdiash Newman deceased before that testimony the Will is ordered by the Court to be Recorded with the above will there is a small account book filed said to be the one referred to in the will The accounts in that book are carefully copied below the Will in the Record book

Examine

In the name of God Amen I Abner Sharp are in sound mind and memory do make this my last Will & Testament (first) I give my Soul to God who gave it (second) I give my wife Mary my household of Land Conistock some 250 acres of land off 500 Dollars in money & all the household goods & kitchen furniture & two of the best Horses & two Horse Waggons & good Cows & calf & 12 Sheep 20 Choise of Hogs & as many of the plow wares & hoes as is necessary for to tend the farm & my wife is to have all of the above as long as she is my Widow & should she marry she is to take the third of which what is left of what I have give to her & and the ballance of the Bucking farm that I own is to be either Rented or sold which my Executor think best if sold it is to be sold to one of my Children and all the ballance of my estate both Real & personal to be sold & as my Children becoms of age & marry each one is to have \$200 Except my son John W & William Offmann John W to have \$100 & William Offs - all of my Children that is married has Received their \$200 & is to have no more of my Estate until all of my Children that is not married gets their \$200 & should there be any more money left it is to be Equally Divided amongst all of my Children & Except my son William & he is only to have his \$1 - as above & should there arise any Dispute among my Children in selling my Estate the person Disputed is to pick one man & my Executor an other man & should them two not agree then to pick another man & them two & then to settle the Dispute & as to Law about my Estate I appoint my wife Mary & my son James

Executor & Coetor & I Request the Judge of the County Court of Buchanan to Receive them
as such & for them not to give any Security as Witness my hand this 16 day of August 1854

County Court Monday September 18th 1854

The within and foregoing writing purporting to be the last Will & Testament of William Sharp was produced in Court and proved by the oaths of G P Duncan & Wm Hall subscribing Witnesses Jurors who came into Court & were that William Sharp published the within Writing as & for his last Will & Testament and that the said William Sharp was of sound mind & disposing Memory at the time of signing said Writing thereupon with this Certificate the same is admitted to Record

Examined I John Dymott of Buchanan County Kentucky being sound in mind and of disposing Memory but in feeble health And far Advanced in life do make and establish this my last will and Testament revoking all other Wills

First I desire that all my just debts & funeral expenses be paid 2nd I will and devise my Yellow man Johnson to my son Andrew R. Dymott (he) Andrew is to take said Johnson at his Valuation and account for it to my estate after deducting said Andrew share or portion of my estate out of the Value of said Slave Johnson 3rd it is my will and desire that my old Black Woman Celia may have the privilege of choosing which of my Children she will live with and to be taken at the Valuation which is to be accounted for in the settlement of & distribution of my estate 4th it is my will and desire that my black girl Susan who is affected with Venereal shall not be disposed of for one year after my death if she shall live so long but shall go with Celia and my Executors hereinafter named shall have Medical Attention given her said evidence to have her cured paying all necessary expenses for her out of my estate and then dispose of her by letting one of my Children have her upon such terms as they may think best 5th I will and devise to my daughter Lucy Clarkson One Dollar I having advanced to her her full share of my estate 6th it is my will & desire that my executors sell all of my personal property on such a credit as they may deem best for the advantage of my estate 7th it is my will and desire that my Executors sell and dispose of the farm on which I now live either privately or publicly upon such credits as they may think right & proper 8th it is my will and desire that after paying my funeral expenses & just debts and expenses arising out of the settlement of my estate and the devise of this Will that the net & residue of my estate be equally divided as follows (viz) To James Dymott One sixth part to Daniel Dymott One sixth part to George Dymott One sixth part to Andrew R. Dymott One sixth part to Susan Pate One sixth part And to Judith Miller One sixth part 9th I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my son Andrew R. Dymott & my son in Law Thomas Miller Executors of this my last Will and Testament 10th it is my will and desire that my said executors or the acting or surviving convey the lands on which my farm and houses are & desired to be sold by this Will also that they or either of them convey any & all lands that I ought or could have conveyed if living In Testimony Whereof I have set my hand & seal the 4th day of July 1853
