And at a County Court began and held for the County of Buchanan at the Courthouse in Harrodsburg on March the 17th day of May 1823 the annexed writing purporting to be the last will and testament of William Fisher dec^d was produced in Court and duly proved by the oath of Thomas William another witness thereto to be the act and deed of the said William Fisher dec^d for the purposes therein mentioned whereupon the same is ordered to be recorded.

In the name of God amen the 3rd day of December 1822 I Jacob Bruner of the County of Buchanan and State of Kentucky being in a low state of health but of disposing mind and memory and knowing the uncertainty of life and the surety of death do make and ordain this my last will and testament First recommending my soul to God the author of its being and my body to the earth from whence it came and as touching my worldly estate which it hath pleased God to bless me with I give devise and dispose of the same in the following manner First it is my will and desire that all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid out of my estate secondly it is my wish that my son John Bruner may sell so much of my property as will pay the above mentioned debts and the same over to my son-in-law as soon as he properly can Third it is my wish and desire that my land house and stock of every description belong to my said wife Catherine Bruner to be her proper right to do with the same as she thinks proper and at her death to dispose of the same to her children as she may choose or think fit & I do further appoint my 2^d wife Catherine Bruner Executrix to this my last will and testament revoking all other will heretofore made and confirm this and no other In Witness whereof I have set my hand and affix my seal this aforesaid 3rd day of December 1822 in the year of Christ 1822.
