So none of the Land is to be sold after the debts are paid, till the Year 1880, then it is to be sold and equally divided among the children the Land I Deeded to E. H. Burfin is for the support of his Mother and Deedamonia but there is nothing to prevent E. H. Burfin from holding the Land so Deeded to him R. H. J. is to have \$50. for minding up the estate and when it is done if that haith enough he is to have \$10. more E. H. Burfin is to have no share in the sale of 1880 - When it is named in this Will that R. H. J. Burfin is to sell the Cloverport Land first he is ordered to sell any other named Land first he may think best
