A L Burch Should then remain at the death of my said wife any of the real or personal property upon said farm then I will ~~divide~~ to the said seven children in the same manner. If my said wife should not survive me then I give and devise all the said property to my said seven children their heirs forever, charging my said children with the payment of my just debts all the rest of my estate both Real and personal of what nature or kind it may be I desire may be equally divided among my several children hereinbefore named which I give to them their heirs Executors Administrators and assigns forever I do hereby constitute and appoint my said wife executor of this my last will and testament
